Located on 200 acres of rolling farmland, we planted our first vines in 1994 and opened as a production winery in 1998.

The Land of Nod Winery offers an array of both grape and fruit wines including Bianca, Pinot Noir, Corot Noir, Raspberry & Blueberry Raspberry Medley. We are always expanding and enhancing our offerings with new varieties.

At the end of February through early April we offer tours of our Sugarhouse as we bring to life the centuries-old tradition of creating pure maple syrup using a wood fire. Come and sample Mother Nature's pure sugar, warm from the evaporator. All of our maple products are sold in the wine shop during our operating season.
